Center Grove Girls Basketball League 1st Grade Rules

All league play will be governed by the IHSAA Federation Rules with the **EXCEPTIONS** as noted in these Center Grove Girls Basketball Rules. This rule includes: <u>NO</u> jewelry is to be worn, which includes earrings, necklaces, bracelets, rings, etc. Also banned are metal clips, pins and ribbons in the hair.

- 1. Basic Game Information
 - a. Game will be played on an 8' basketball goal.
 - b. This league will use a 27.5" girls' basketball.
 - c. Free throws will be shot from 12'. There will be no infraction for a player going over the line while shooting a free throw.
 - d. If a team is short girls, the game can be played four on four. If there are fewer girls than that available to one team, the game is considered a forfeit, but the two teams should equally split the girls available and play a game.
 - e. **No** overtime periods.
- 2. All games will be four, eight (8) minute running quarters. There will be a scheduled break in the play at the four (4) minute mark of each quarter for a mandatory substitution. **No** player may play more than ½ quarter more than any other girl on a team.
 - a. Each coach should have a plan for each game, using some sort of rotation chart to ensure that this happens. It will be tracked in the score book as well.
 - b. In the event of an injury or a late arriving or early leaving player, every effort should be made to ensure all players play equal time.
- 3. **This is a developmental league**. Every girl should be allowed to bring the ball up the court on both dead and live ball situations and given every opportunity to score during every game.
 - a. No team should have a designated "ball handler" in this league
- 4. There will be **no** pressing allowed at any time during the game.
- 5. Defense will be girl-to-girl and <u>no</u> type of zone is allowed. Switching can be taught, but <u>no</u> double teaming or trapping is allowed outside of the free throw lane.
- 6. There will be **no** steals off the dribble. Once a player picks up their dribble, the ball cannot be tied up or stolen.
- 7. You are allowed to steal a pass.
- 8. There will be **no** fast breaking. Once a team gains control of the possession of the ball in the back court off a live ball, they must let the defense get back.
- 9. A player scoring 10 points in one half will be "pointed out" for the remainder of that half. They may continue to play, but not score. If they score a basket, it will not be counted as a basket.
- 10. A player scoring 14 points in any one game will be "pointed out" for the remainder of the game. They may continue playing, but not score. If they score a basket, it will not be counted a basket.
- 11. Halftime will be five (3) minutes and there will be a 5–10-minute clock between each game, depending on the game schedule.
- 12. There will be one official for each game. The official will act as the League Commissioner and have final say on all rules and any discrepancies or special circumstances.
